YOU WILL NEED

- Printer & paper
- Scissors or guillotine
- Laminator & pouches (optional)
- Velcro dots (optional)
- Zip-lock bags or envelopes for storage (optional)



PREPARATION

1. Print the story board(s), story cards, and Story Retell Page if desired.
2. Select "Fit to Printable Area" (or similar) if required.
3. Cut out the story cards along the dotted lines.
4. Laminate for durability if desired.
5. Attach Velcro dots to the story boards and cards (optional).
6. Store each story set separately in a bag or envelope.



HOW TO USE

Sequencing Activity

1. Choose a story board (3, 4 or 5 steps) that best suits your students' ability level.
2. Select a matching story card set and mix up the cards.
3. Have students place the cards in the correct sequence.
4. Encourage students to explain what happened first, next, then, after, and last.

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HOW TO USE (Continued)

Story Retell Extension



1. After completing the sequencing activity, have students complete the included Story Retell Page.
2. Students can:
 - Write a title for the story.
 - Describe what the story is about.
 - Retell what happened first, next, and how the story ended.
 - Draw and illustrate their favourite part of the story.
3. This extension activity helps strengthen sequencing, comprehension, oral language, and writing skills.

Cut & Paste Activity

1. Use the black & white version.
2. Cut out the story cards.
3. Glue the cards onto the correct story board in sequence.
4. Complete the "This story is about..." section.
5. Colour the pictures when finished.
